



History of Correct Tech, LLC

In January of 2007, after a distinguished 25 year career with the New Mexico Corrections Department, Mr. Drake retired from government service and started a Correct Tech, LLC, a corrections technology consulting company. For much of this time he has been under contract with the National Law Enforcement and Corrections Technology Center to provide technical assistance to agencies developing offender tracking programs. He was also tasked with developing and overseeing a web-based Electronic Monitoring Resource Center and acting as the co-facilitator of NIJ's offender tracking standards initiative.

Mr. Drake is best known for his pioneering work in offender tracking technologies. Before GPS satellites were ever launched, he was working with scientists at Sandia National Laboratories to develop offender tracking technologies. His work has been published in engineering and corrections journals.

Correct Tech, LLC has provided technical assistance to dozens of state, local and federal agencies who were either starting or refining electronic monitoring programs. The company is also involved in several international projects. Correct Tech, LLC completed a comprehensive consulting project with the government of the Cayman Islands in which bidding documents were developed and the bids were evaluated and a successful vendor was selected. Mr. Drake recently finished a consulting project with the Correctional Services of Canada, an agency that is planning a national roll out of an electronic GPS tracking program. The Mauritius Police Force has also chosen to work with Mr. Drake in the planning, procurement and initiation of an offender tracking program on the island.

Mr. Drake holds a Master of Business Administration degree from New Mexico Highlands University with an undergraduate degree in Psychology.
