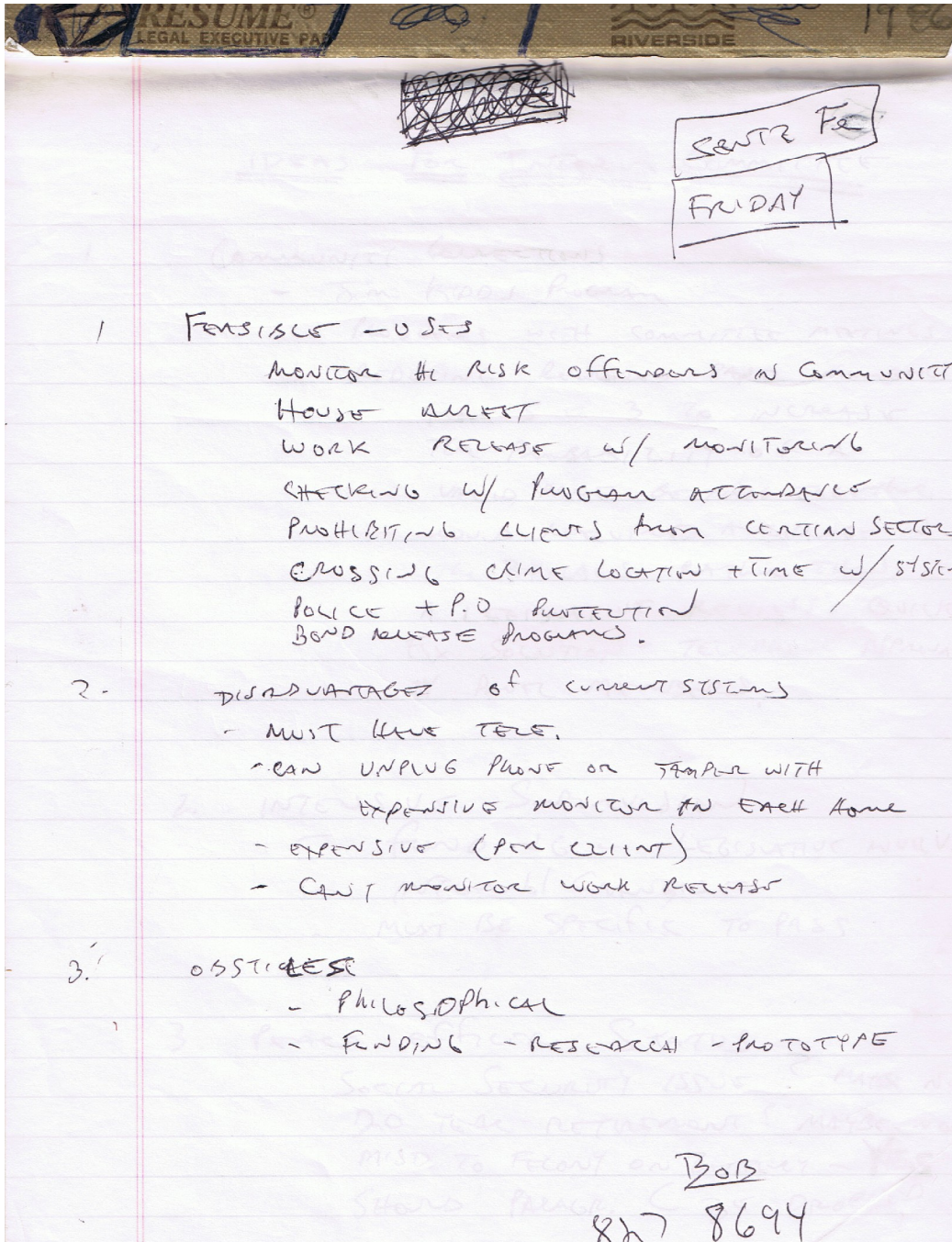


## Early Offender Tracking Notes of George B. Drake



This is the first known documentation of the offender tracking concept. This is a scan from Drake's personal notes of September 23, 1986. Mr. Drake contemplates some uses for the technology, notes the disadvantages of the current system (RF - home detention devices), and lists a couple of obstacles that existed in developing an offender tracking system. His thoughts were scribbled down during a staff meeting, the date of which is documented on the following page in the notebook. The name "Bob" refers to NM Probation Parole Director Robert Squalia, who was heading the agency at the time.
